Liquid Paraffin Emulsion

DEFINITION

Liquid Paraffin Oral Emulsion contains Liquid Paraffin in a suitable vehicle.

The oral emulsion complies with the requirements stated under Oral Liquids and with the following requirements.

Content of liquid paraffin

44.0 to 49.0% w/w.

ASSAY

To 5 g add 10 mL of <u>water</u>, extract with two 40-mL quantities of a mixture of 2 volumes of <u>ethanol</u> (96%), 3 volumes of <u>petroleum spirit</u> (boiling range, 40° to 60°) and 3 volumes of <u>ether</u> and then with 30 mL of a mixture of equal volumes of <u>petroleum spirit</u> (boiling range, 40° to 60°) and <u>ether</u>. Wash the combined extracts with 15 mL of 0.5M <u>sodium hydroxide</u> and then with 15 mL of <u>water</u>, evaporate the solvent, add 5 mL of <u>acetone</u> and evaporate again. Repeat the addition and evaporation of <u>acetone</u> until the residue is free from water, dry at 105° for 15 minutes and weigh.
