Indication: Hypertonic saline nasal spray is a medical device intended to relieve the symptoms of the common cold in adults and children from 3 years of age. It clears congestion, facilitates breathing and

### Mechanism of action:

Hypertonic saline nasal spray forms a protective layer on the nasal mucosa that acts as a barrier against viruses and bacteria; it reduces swelling, softens and moisturizes irritated nasal mucosa.

The mechanism of action of hypertonic saline nasal spray is based on the liquefaction of nasal secretion and the resulting improvement in mucociliary

### Dosage and use (adults and children from 3 years):

Shake before use. Hold the bottle upright and insert the tip of the nasal spray bottle into the nose.

### Side effect(s):

Some people may experience nasal irritation and burning,
